Small bucket or pail

Diluted disinfectants should be changed each day or better yet mix up just before using.  
 All disinfectants should be effective after 5 minutes of contact time. Disinfectants are more effective at warmer temperatures. Diluted disinfectants should be changed each day or better yet mix up just before using.  
 Disinfectants—Environ<sup>T</sup>, Virkon S<sup>T</sup>, Nolvasan, or other disinfectants—mix according to label directions. Bleach and water (3/4 cup bleach per gallon of water). Handle bleach with care. Clean boots and equipment of debris before disinfecting. Disinfectants should be effective after 5 minutes of contact time. Disinfectants are more effective at warmer temperatures. Diluted disinfectants should be changed each day or better yet mix up just before using.

Soap—mild detergent

Brush

Disposable coveralls—fabric type, optional if you change your clothes

Plastic Boots—4 mil or 6 mil plastic boots or other tough disposable boots

Disposable Rubber Gloves
